

**Adult Center for Enrichment, Inc.
Annual Program Evaluation 2007-08
Quality Measures**

Participants attending the Adult Center for Enrichment's adult day centers and group respite programs reported the following:

- Feel better coming to the program 94%
- Experience less pain 58%
- Enjoy activities 96%
- Receive help as needed 100%
- Treated with dignity and respect 99%
- Coming enriches their lives 96%
- Are satisfied with coming to ACE 99%

Caregivers with loved one's attending the Adult Center for Enrichment' adult day centers and group respite programs reported the following:

- Utilizing adult day services made it possible to continue working 99%
- Experienced reduced stress since using ADS 87%
- Felt job performance had improved 54%
- Increased knowledge of community resources 89%
- Attending has kept family member out of a long term care facility 87%
- Would recommend to a friend or relative 100%
- Other options would cost more 88%

All of the participants at the Adult Center for Enrichment have a chronic illness from which they will not recover. A primary goal of the Adult Center is to assist in maintaining or improving the status of the participant within the limitations of their chronic disease. The following status was perceived in their family member participants by primary caregivers:

- Maintain or expand conversation or communication 91% (66% improved)
- Maintain or Improve mobility/flexibility 88% (43% improved)
- Maintain or increase interest in personal hygiene 84% (24% increased)
- No increase in emergency care episodes 93% (46% decrease)
- Maintain or Improve medical condition 92% (34% improved)

- Value of services, worth the cost 100% of those that responded

Of those families experiencing difficult behaviors due to a specific illness:

- No increase in difficult behaviors 88% (35% decrease)
- Improved sleep patterns 32%
